Dear Charleston County Councilmembers

The recent discussions by County Council relative to addressing the pressing need to solve the transportation problems on River Road and Bohicket Road on Johns Island have caused all of us to take a hard look at the options available to us. Recently, I have had the opportunity to meet with and talk to Mayor Wert of Kiawah and Mayor McNulty of Seabrook, and the three of us agree that we would like to participate as partners with the county in finding a solution for an additional road on Johns Island. We believe that the best way to move forward would be for the mayors of the affected municipalities to sit down with the leaders of the county government and devise a process in which we all agree to participate in to help us reach a consensus solution that we all support.

Therefore, I would respectfully request that County Council defer voting on any motion to create a committee to study this problem until we have been able to put together the process I have described above. I am very confident that we can come together as sister governments to devise a solution that works well for all parties concerned.
