

1		SCRR Chapter 71, 1-1910.156(c)(4): Failed to inform fire brigade members about special hazards such as storage and use of flammable liquids and gases, toxic chemicals, radioactive sources, and water reactive substances, to which they may be exposed during fire and other emergencies. The fire brigade members shall also be advised of any changes that occur in relation to the special hazards. The employer shall develop and make available for inspection by fire brigade members, written procedures that describe the actions to be taken in situations involving the special hazards and shall include these in the training and education program as follows: A. Standard operating procedures were not developed to cover the special hazards associated with fighting and attacking a fire involving a metal truss roof.	10/23/07	\$900.

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

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
