

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

1		SCRR Chapter 71, 1-1910.36(d)(1): Failed to ensure employees are able to open an exit route door from the inside at all times without keys, tools, or special knowledge. A device such as a panic bar that locks only from the outside is permitted on exit discharge doors, as follows: A. Exit doors on the front and rear of warehouse of the establishment were padlocked on or about June 18, 2007. B. Two sets of double hung exit doors on the left side of the casual showroom were locked with sliding bolts on the top and bottom of the doors on or about June 18, 2007. C. Exit door on right side of decor showroom of the establishment was padlocked on or about June 18, 2007.	10/03/07	\$29400.
